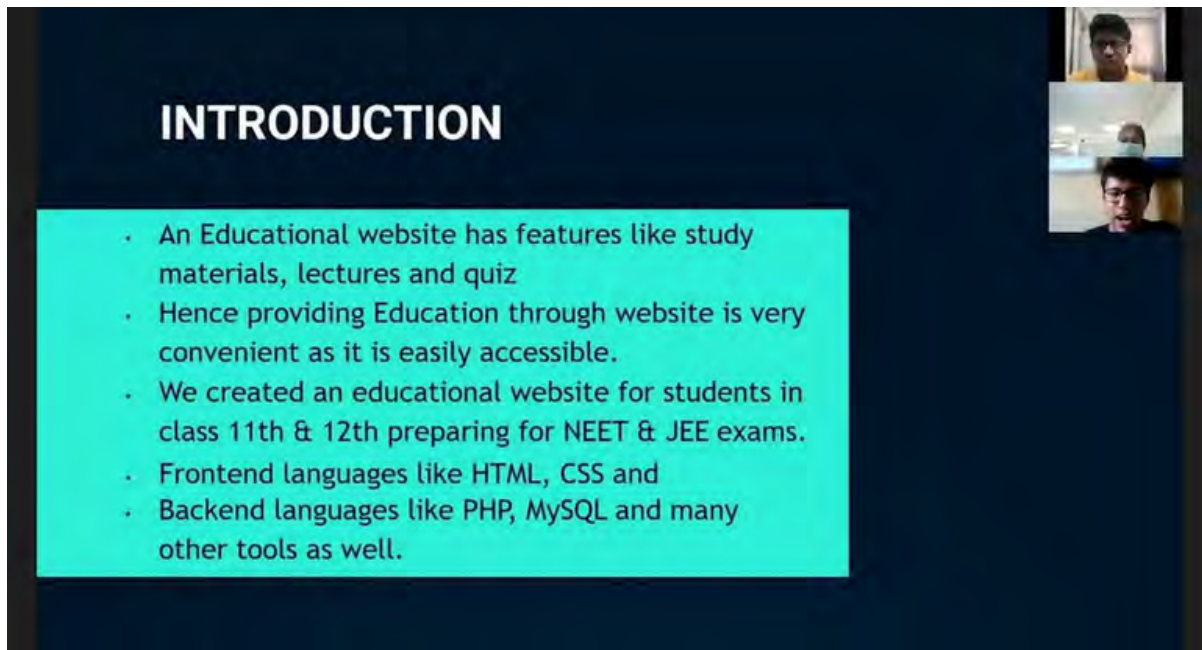

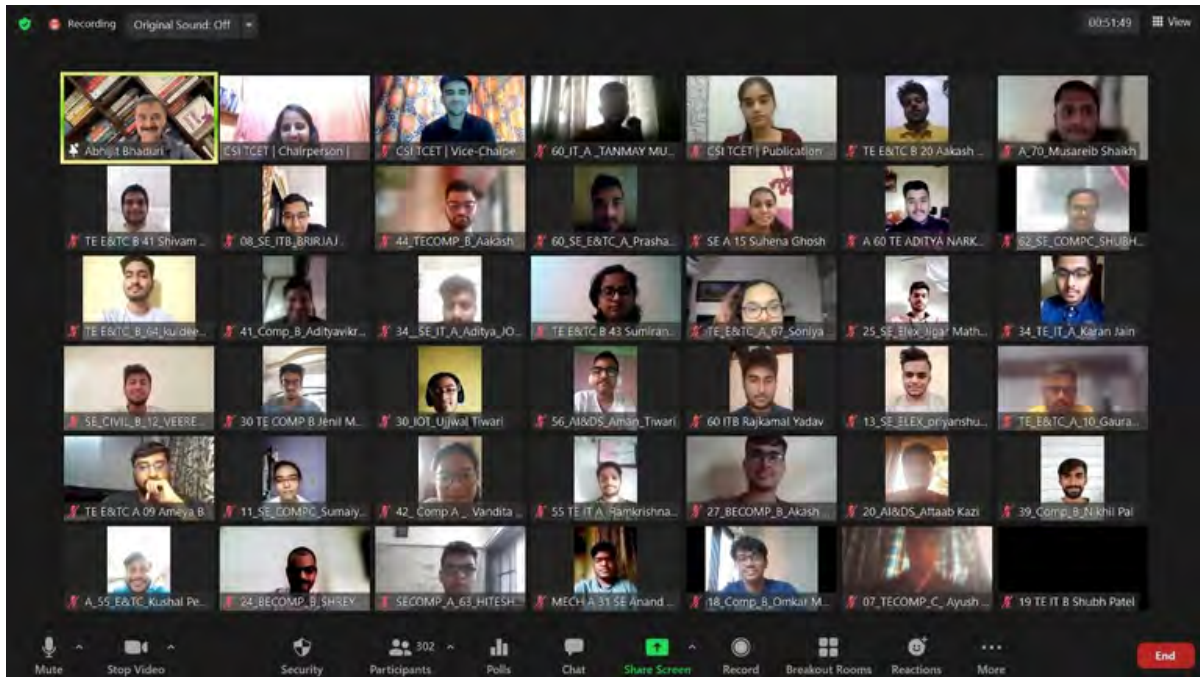
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Website Development Competition

Webinar on Acing the Job Interview



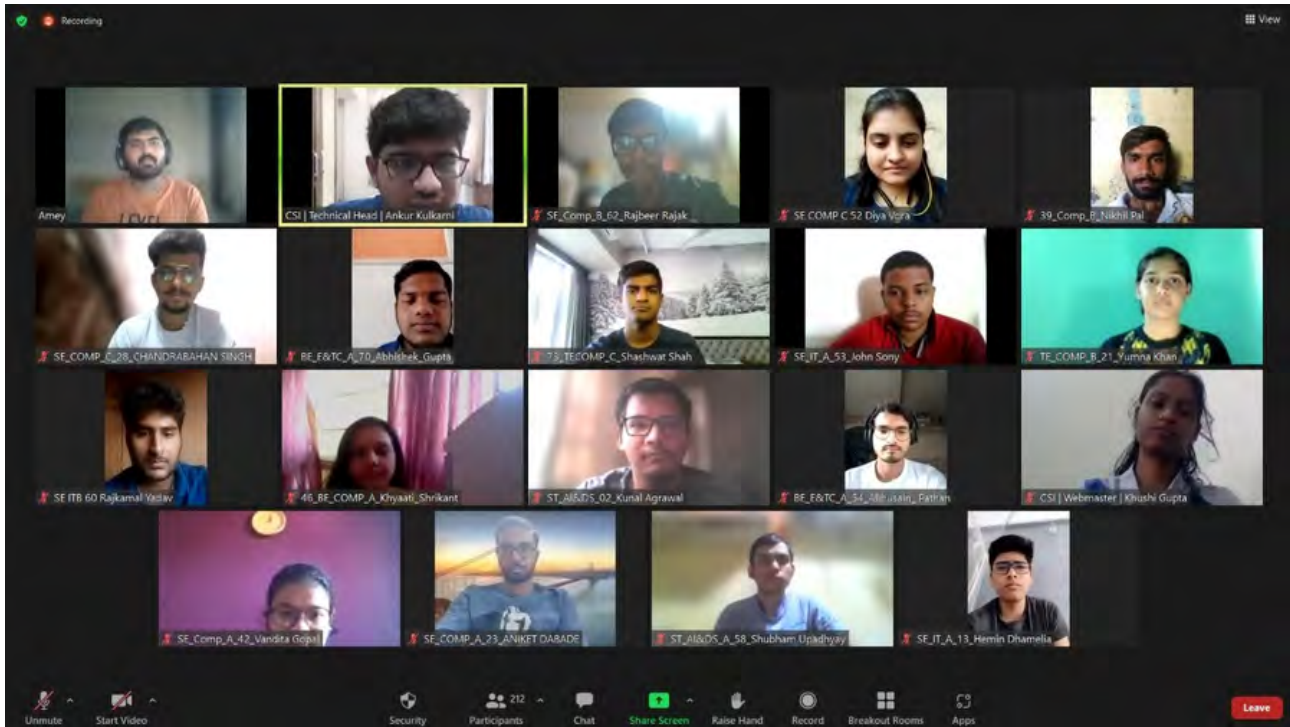

Workshop on Blockchain (Multicon)



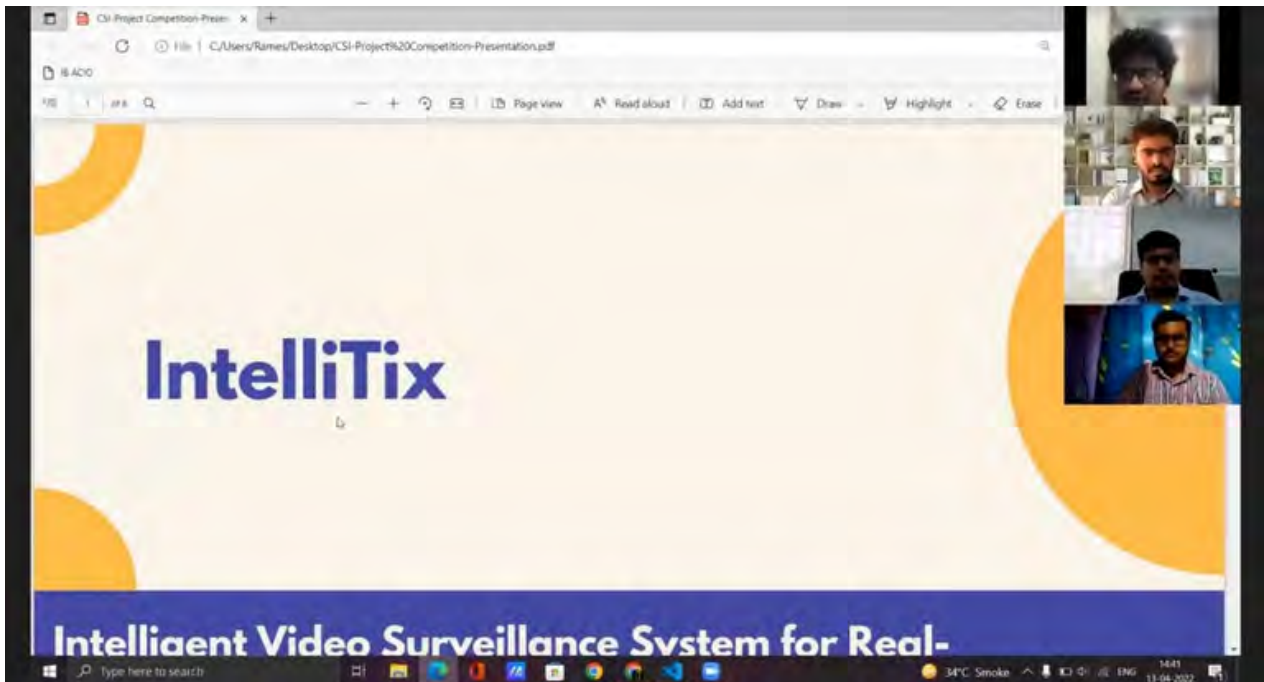
